

Volvo India launches new luxury SUV for ₹55.9 lakh

SWEDISH LUXURY car company Volvo Cars launched the new XC60 in India for ₹55.9 lakh, ex-showroom. It replaces the successful original XC60 which has been the largest selling model for Volvo globally and in India. There is just one, fully-loaded variant, which gets the 1969cc diesel engine (235bhp) and features such as air suspension, panoramic sunroof, radar-enabled preventive safety, Bowers & Wilkins 15-speaker surround sound, and massage seats. Charles Frump, the new MD of Volvo Auto India, said during the launch in Delhi, "The XC60 makes up almost a third of our sales here. Our commitment to launch quickly after the global launch emphasises our intent in India."The SUV gets 8-speed automatic gearbox, and semi-automatic parking, i.e. if you bring it to a lane-marked parking area, the car will automatically steer itself into the parking space.
